Chenla Children's Healthcare works within the pediatric wards of the Cambodian government referral hospitals to greatly strengthen the government system's ability to provide compassionate, high-quality care. Utilizing existing government facilities, medication, supplies, and staff, combined with Chenla's NGO resources, the hospital provides compassionate international-standard medical care to children suffering from infectious disease, febrile illness, premature birth, and a broad range of other pediatric diseases.

The hospital is located inside the Kratie Provincial Hospital, a government-run facility in Eastern Cambodia. Almost all of the staff are Cambodians who provide both inpatient and outpatient services including a Neonatal and Pediatric ICU. The staff also coordinator medical outreach activities to the eastern part of Cambodia.
