Philippine Children's Medical Center (PCMC)

- PCMC is a Level IV training hospital (one of only three in the country), with an authorized 212-bed capacity, serving patients from newborn to 19 years old, as well as high-risk pregnant women. It has the largest ICU for children in the country. It also has the most comprehensive pediatric rehabilitation facility and the most extensive pediatric multi-specialty for inpatients, as well as for clinic service to out-patients and referrals. Among these are the Cancer and Hematology Center; Adolescent Center (Teen Republic); Pediatric Lung, Heart, Kidney and Liver Center; Pediatric Critical Care Center, and; the Clinical Centers for General Pediatric Services and Surgical & Allied Medical Services, respectively
